ADVERTISING ON THE GREEN

The Parish Council has agreed that village voluntary groups can advertise village events on the Green as long as the group asks permission from the Clerk (who will advise them about size) and are erected no longer than 28 days before an event and taken down 7 days after the event.

OVERNIGHT CAMPING ON THE RECREATIONAL GROUND

It has come to the Parish Council's attention that groups of locals have been camping on the Recreational Ground overnight without prior permission. This has caused problems with noise, overflowing litter bins plus the fact that there are no toilet facilities at the Recreational Ground. Therefore, no camping on the Recreational Ground is allowed without prior permission. The Parish Council may allow camping for organised village events where there will be an agreement to adhere to the Council rules.

SWIMMING POOL COMMITTEE

The summer season is about over and the swimming pool will be 'put to bed' until next year. It has been a very successful year with more people using the pool during the hot summer months. However, this has come with some problems so the Parish Council will be issuing a new set of rules for next year's season. The Parish Council would like to set up a Swimming Pool Committee consisting of a Councillor and volunteers in the next month or so to get procedures in place ready for action for next year's season. EMAIL GROUP

In the April's newsletter the council reported that the Email Group of over 100 recipients was being suspended due to the email addresses which couldn't be transferred to a new lap top. Also, at this time the new General Data Protection Act Regulations had come into force and it was still unclear how these new regulations would affect Council contacts. Now after several requests, the Council is going to set up the email group again. So, if you would like to receive Council agendas and other bits and pieces of news, please contact the Clerk with your email address. The Council will send you a Consent Form which you will have to fill in and sign. (It has to be a signed) Once filled in and signed you can either scan it and send back by email or send back by post. In the meantime, you can always view agendas and minutes on the web site. The Council's General Privacy Policy can also be viewed on the web site.

DEFIBRILLATOR

The defibrillator is now in position on the outside wall of the Village Hall and is ready to use if the need arises. You can obtain the code to open the cabinet by ringing 999 and the operator will give you the code. Then it is a matter of following the verbal instructions from the defibrillator until an ambulance arrives.

Training to use the defibrillator has already taken place but there will be more new training or refresher training later in the year.

WAR MEMORIAL

At last, the cleaning of the War Memorial is finished and the Council is very pleased with the results and very pleased that it has been completed by the 100th anniversary of the end of WW1 on 11 November 2018. The Council is in the process of claiming an agreed grant from the Wall Memorial Trust of £1377.
