Defibrillator

The Clerk reported that a representative from Heartstart has had the cabinet refurbished after the seals were broken when it was taken off from the old hall's wall. This will cost around £140. The defibrillator can be installed early in the new year

After discussion it was stated that the defibrillator is not actually owned by the Parish Council but it was agreed to take on the cost of getting the defibrillator installed at the new hall (refurbishment & electrician) as it is central to the village.
