Discussion: Tintinhull is quite unique as a small Local Authority with a facility of a swimming pool. However, the swimming pool is very expensive to run and maintain with an average loss of over £5000 a year for the last 5 years. This is funded by the precept.
Consideration: Does this parish need a swimming pool considering the cost to the rate payer.
The Meeting voted overwhelmingly to keep the Swimming Pool
